**Marie-Noelle Berthelet**, Principal Flute of the Regina Symphony Orchestra, graduate of the University of Montreal and New England Conservatory, Boston. Awarded the Governor General's Medal by the Conservatoire de Musique de Trois-Rivieres.

From Joliette, Quebec, Marie-Noelle now lives in Regina, also performs with the RSO Chamber Players, and is a member of the period-instrument ensemble Per Sonatori. She performs contemporary music with the University of Regina New Music Ensemble and as solist with ensembles across Canada. She teaches at the University of Regina and at the Regina Conservatory of Performing Arts.

**Cécile Denis**, a virtuoso of both pedal and celtic harp, is Principal Harp of the Regina and Saskatoon Symphony Orchestras. The holder of a Masters Degree in Performance from the University of Toronto Ms. Denis has performed in North America and Europe and has been a featured guest artist with the Regina Symphony Orchestra. She has recorded two CDs: *Harposphere* featuring celtic harp and *Nocturnes* for harp and French horn.

Ms. Denis is harp instructor at the University of Regina, Conservatory of Performing Arts.

**Simon Fryer** is an artist of the utmost versatility. Artistic Director of the Women's Musical Club of Toronto, Simon is in demand for his teaching, coaching and masterclass skills. Formerly a member of the Juno-winning Penderecki String Quartet and the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, his discography of over 20 recordings includes the solo CD: *Music of a life so far...* which was acclaimed as 'a fascinating collection' by the Toronto Star and the recently released Victorian English Sonatas with pianist Leslie De'Ath. Simon has previously held faculty positions at Wilfrid Laurier University, the University of Toronto, the Glenn Gould School and is now teaching at Regina Conservatory for the Performing Arts.
